

## The water is saved and managed by using dams and reservoirs along the river.




Reservoirs are created to store the water that we will use later.

### **IRRIGATION WATER**


SSJID uses a system of canals to bring the water to farmers in our community. The water travels300 MILES to reach their crops!





SSJID maintains and repairs the canals so farmers can get the water they need when they need it.

## **DOMESTIC WATER** Water is also saved to be used in our homes by families like yours.



## Our domestic water is stored in Woodward Reservoir near Oakdale.



## From there it is piped to a water treatment plant to be tested and processed.









SSJID processes over 40 million gallons of water every day to be sure it is safe for people in our communities to drink and use.









### SSJID wants you to be **SAFE** around water



## **ELECTRICITY GENERATION** SSJID also uses water to produce ELECTRICITY called HYDROPOWER.




# HYDROPOWER is electricity generated by capturing the energy of moving water.
