SOUTH SAN JOAQUIN IRRIGATION DISTRICT INTRODUCES NEWLY APPOINTED BOARD MEMBER

On August 3, 2021, the South San Joaquin Irrigation District Board of Directors appointed Glenn Spyksma of Ripon, CA as the new Division 2 director, replacing the late Ralph Roos who passed away in June 2021. The appointment comes after a publicly advertised search for eligible candidates and a formal interview process.

Spyksma is a retired Executive Vice President of The Wine Group, and has 37 years of management and engineering experience in the food processing industry. He holds a degree in Mechanical Engineering from Sacramento State. A native of Ripon, CA, Spyksma's family includes his wife of 39 years Carla, 4 children, and 5 grandchildren. In addition to his new board appointment, Spyksma stays active in the community, serving on the boards of Calvary Reformed Church and the Central California Classis, participating in regional church leadership, mentorship and training.
