NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the South San Joaquin Groundwater Sustainability Agency (SSJGSA) will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, July 20, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the South San Joaquin Irrigation District, 11011 E. Highway 120, Manteca, California, to consider public comments on whether the SSJGSA should adopt the Revised Eastern San Groundwater Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Plan. All interested persons are invited to attend said hearing and may provide comments on the matter. This Public Hearing is being held pursuant to California Water Code Section 10728.4 which was created by the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) which was passed by the Legislature and signed by the Governor in 2014.

The SSJGSA is a partnership between the Cities of Ripon and Escalon, and the South San Joaquin Irrigation District.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the SSJGSA may take action to adopt the Final ESJ GSP immediately following the close of the Public Hearing.
